General Safety Protocols

- **No spectators will be allowed. No exceptions. Skaters who need help with tying of skates will need to do so outside the building.**
- To secure the building, the entry/exit doors will remain locked at all times.
- There will be no access to change rooms. Skaters must arrive to the arena dressed.
- There will be access to washrooms however should be used only on an emergency basis.
- Face masks must be worn in the building, but are optional on the ice
- Skaters will enter through 1 designated entry door.
- Skaters will exit through 1 designated exit door.
- Stickers/signage will be placed throughout the building to maintain physical distancing, which includes, but is not limited to: walkways, waiting areas, benches, boards etc.
- Skaters who do not pass the Skate Ontario Health Questionnaire will not be permitted access to the building.
- Skaters and coaches are expected to maintain physical distancing at all times.
- All other areas of the community centre, including the spectator area, will be closed off.
- Dryland warm-up will not be allowed inside the building.
- Skaters must register online. If a skater has not registered, they will not be allowed entry. There will be absolutely no exceptions.
- As per Skate Ontario, the maximum number of people allowed on the ice at one time is 20.

Skater Entry/Exit Procedure

1. Skaters must arrive a minimum of 15 minutes before their session begins. Staff will open the door 15 minutes before the session begins and allow skaters who have registered online to come inside. Attendance will be taken. Skaters who have not registered will not be allowed in. No exceptions.
2. Skaters who arrive late will not be allowed entry. There will be no refunds, credits or make-up sessions.
3. Skaters will be led as a group to where they may leave their bags and get changed into their skates.
4. Skaters must keep their face masks on until they are on the ice and must put their mask back on once they are off the ice.
5. After a session has finished, skaters will be able to change their skates and will be led as a group to the designated exit door where they can meet their parents outside.
